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### **FESTIVAL DINNER TICKETS**

Dinner tickets will go on sale on Monday, September 26<sup>th</sup>. They can be purchased from any elementary school (3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> Grade), or high school student (7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade), or at the Ministry Center and School Offices. Persons calling the Ministry Center may have tickets set aside to be picked up at a later date. The prices for the tickets will be \$12.00 for adults and \$9.00 for children (5<sup>th</sup> grade and under). Persons purchasing tickets should give the student the money for the tickets plus the desired reservation time for either Saturday or Sunday. The student will then give the ticket to the buyer. Drive-thru tickets are marked as such. No reservations are necessary for the Drive-thru tickets. Make sure the seller is a student of St. Johns.

**Drive-thru dinners will be available from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Saturday and from 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. on Sunday.** Drive-thru dinners will be in a Styrofoam container. **Dinners in**

**the All Saints Building will be served from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday and 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.** Parking available for dine-in in the High School Parking Lot. Follow the signs through the courtyard into the Breezeway. Enter the All Saints Building. This process will make it easier for the disabled, handicapped and the elderly. The dinner ticket campaign will end for the students on October 12<sup>th</sup>. Remaining reserved or Drive-thru tickets can be purchased at the Ministry Center through October 14<sup>th</sup>. Dinner tickets will also be available at the door if any tickets remain. As a reminder, please bring your own boxes, laundry baskets, etc. with you to pick up dinners for drive-thru orders. Please remain in your cars as we will load your dinners for you.

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### **DINE-IN INFORMATION**

Dinners will be a one-trip buffet style with special requests available. Cranberries will be unavailable due to availability and pricing. Dinners will include: Chicken or beef, dressing, mashed potatoes/gravy, noodles, vegetable, dinner roll, baked apples, pie or cake, coleslaw and gelatin and drink. If you are unable to finish your meal, take home boxes will be available.

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### **HOME DELIVERIES OF FESTIVAL DINNERS**

We are now taking orders for home deliveries of the festival dinners. Please remember that this service is only for those who are shut-in and elderly people who are physically unable to stand in line for long periods of time.
