SEMINARIAN'S TAKE

Greetings Friends,

We have finished the Christmas Season and are now into the third week of Ordinary Time. Did you ever wonder "what's the purpose of Ordinary Time?" Ordinary time is not just filler time between Christmas and Lent or any other big seasons. There is a purpose to Ordinary time. The purpose is that we grow closer in our relationship with Christ. That through knowing the life of Christ, we can sanctify our own ordinary moments of life. Jesus has a special love for the ordinary. He was born into an ordinary family with no great wealth or influence; he grew up working in an ordinary job, he was a carpenter, and finally, he chose ordinary men to be his disciples. There is great holiness in the ordinary, so this Ordinary time of the Church is still very important.

During this time, we are encouraged to grow closer in friendship with Jesus, but how can we do that? What does having a friendship with Jesus look like? Let's look at Jesus's own friends in scripture and see what they were like. In the Gospel Story when Jesus visits Martha and Mary (Luke 10:38-42), we see an example of Jesus with his friends. Martha and Mary were friends of Jesus, so what are some of their characteristics?

"Now as they went on their way, he entered a certain village where a woman named Martha welcomed him. She had a sister named Mary, who sat at Jesus's feet and listened to what he was saying. But Martha was distracted by her many tasks, so she came to him and asked, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her then to help me." But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things, but few things are needed—indeed only one. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her." (Luke 10:38-42)

The first thing you notice about Martha is that she welcomes Jesus in. Martha goes out and brings Jesus into her home, inviting Him to enter into her life and family. I think that is the first characteristic of a friend of Jesus, to welcome Him into your home, to invite Jesus into your life.

The Second thing we notice about Martha is that she goes to Jesus to tell Him her problem. Martha's question sounds negative, but let's look rather at the way she asks. Martha is bold and honest. She doesn't just sit there and complain about her sister quietly to others, rather she honestly and boldly brings her need to Jesus. This is a great quality of a friend of Jesus, one who takes his or her need boldly and honestly to Jesus.

The third thing we notice is about Mary. What we notice about Mary is that she sits quietly at the feet of Jesus and Listens. There are two actions that she performs which are important for us to follow. First, she sits at the feet of Jesus. She is close to Jesus. She places herself near Jesus. Secondly, she listens. Mary is attentive to what Jesus says. I think these two things again are important characteristics of a friend of Jesus.

These three things can be incorporated into our prayer so that we can grow closer in our relationship with Jesus and are ordinary things you would do with any good friend. We need to first, Welcome Jesus into our life, second Boldly and Honestly bring our needs to Jesus, and lastly, sit with Jesus and listen to His words. Thinking about these characteristics in our prayer can increase our friendship with Jesus during this Ordinary Time.




