**HAVE YOU HEARD?!**

Delphos St. John's church will soon be equipped with assistive listening technology from LISTEN Technologies. Assistive Listening refers to the act of hearing more clearly using a device or technology.

Assistive listening devices are different than hearing aids, they are typically installed systems that the end-user has access to while they are in the space. There will be a "loop" installed under the church and our Wi-Fi will be updated to accommodate this technology for those with hearing loss. In our church, like many others, it is a very reverberant environment where sounds from all around echo and bounce throughout the space. Assistive listening devices can be used to expand the functionality of a hearing aid or cochlear implant by amplifying the sounds you want to hear with limited interference or unwanted noise. If you would like to help fund this project, which is expected to cost around \$9,000.00, contact the Ministry Center at 419-695-4050.

Always be Ready

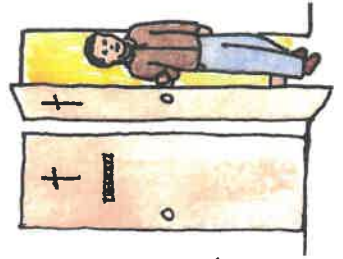

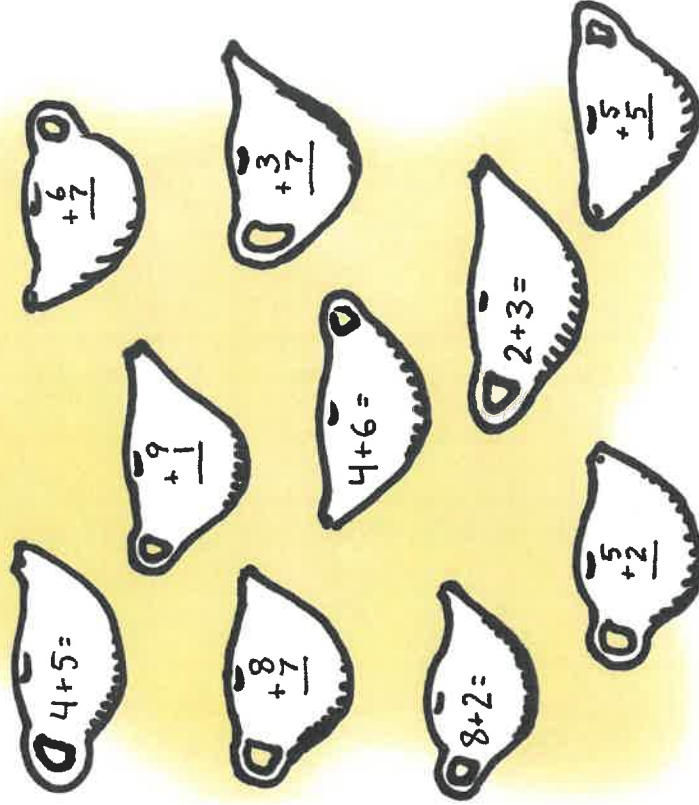

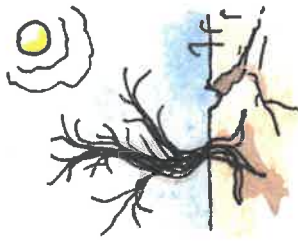

THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY By: Jack Bockey



Did you know that Elida Avenue originally turned at Douglas Street and went Southeast until it got to the railroad tracks, then followed the tracks to Elida? In June of 1928, the 1883 addition and a

small new addition of the cemetery were surveyed. Sometime between 1930 and 1944, Elida Avenue was moved to the angle it is today. In 1948, the cemetery was expanded, and old Elida Avenue was incorporated as a driveway in the new addition. This is the drive that runs at an angle. A 1948 map of the cemetery shows that every drive and walk has a name, and although most of the walks are no longer there, you can tell where they were.
