HAVE YOU HEARD?! Delphos St. John's Church will soon be equipped with assistive listening technology from LISTEN Technologies. There will be a "loop" installed under the church and our Wi-Fi will be updated to accommodate this technology for those with hearing loss. The Wi-Fi audio distribution will transmit audio directly to smartphones using our existing network. Parishioners and guests may listen via a free app and their own earbuds or stream to Bluetooth enabled hearing aids and cochlear implants. The Cemeteries: Part 3. In 1970, Fr. Ottenweller found it necessary to purchase land for a new cemetery as the old cemetery was getting full.

After parishioners were surveyed, it was decided to have tombstones that are flush with the ground. A new cemetery was designed and planned East of town at the corner of Defiance Trail Road and Lincoln Highway. The new cemetery was named Resurrection Cemetery and landscape and roadways were completed in 1971. It was in 1978, a chapel was constructed to serve as a focal point and shelter for graveside services. In 2003, a section was designed for upright monuments.

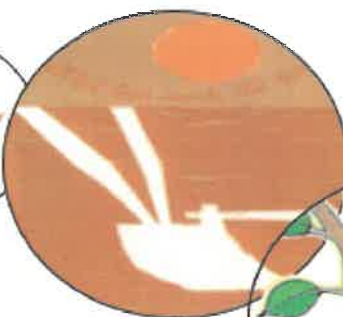

GRIEFSHARE

As outlined during the Masses this weekend (and last weekend in Spencerville and Landeck parishes), the inaugural session of GriefShare will begin on Thursday evening, January 4, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at the Delphos St. John Annex.

No matter what the circumstances, grief is a painful, confusing process. A GriefShare group is a safe, welcoming place where people understand the difficult emotions of grief. At this 14-week support group program, you'll discover what to expect in the days ahead and what's "normal" in grief. Since there are no neat, orderly stages of grief, you'll learn helpful ways of coping with grief, in all its unpredictability – and gain solid support each step of the way.

At each weekly meeting, you will view a video featuring respected counselors, pastors, and healthcare professionals on grief-related topics, plus you'll hear relatable personal stories of grief. After that, is a small-group discussion to allow people time to talk, share support, and personally apply what they learned on the video. Everyone will receive a book to take home filled with valuable exercises for navigating their personal grieving process.

Topics include how to manage grief-related emotions such as loneliness, anxiety, sadness, anger, and regret; how to cope with the changes in your life and relationships; and how to recognize what's normal in grief and what to do if you feel stuck or hopeless.

GriefShare group participants have repeatedly shared that they feel comforted and encouraged by being in a place where people truly understand what they're going through. And they feel a sense of relief when they're given guidance and tips on how to deal with the daily challenges. You may attend all of the sessions, or come when you can; however, the more sessions you attend, the better your experience will be.

Your bereavement experience may be recent or not so recent. No matter how long it's been, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling.

If you have experienced the death of a family member or friend, you are invited to attend. This 14-week program will be facilitated by volunteers from our parish. Registration will be limited to parishioners from Delphos St. John the Evangelist, Landeck St. John the Baptist and St. Patrick's parish in Spencerville until December 4, 2023 and then will be open to the general public after that date.

Each year, the Diocese of Toledo is required to undergo an audit to ensure that it is in compliance with the articles of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. The past year's audit was a data collection process, examining the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. Bishop Daniel Thomas is pleased to announce that the Diocese was found to be in full compliance with the requirements in the Charter following the audit.
