### THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY By: Jack Bockey



The rectory: Part 1. The first rectory of our parish was the main floor of the first church obeying a church law at the time saying that the blessed sacrament could not be kept under a bedroom. It was built in 1844 at what is now 212 North Main Street. This was used as the rectory until the Sisters of St. Francis came in 1866 and at this time it was given to the sisters who would teach the girls of the parish. Fr. Westerholt, who was now pastor,

announced that the parish would build a new rectory on the south side of Second Street. He took temporary residence at the home of Charles Shenk. To be continued next week.

# HELP PROTECT THE DIGNITY OF LIFE IN OHIO

Life in its earliest and most vulnerable stages is threatened by groups proposing an amendment to the Ohio Constitution for the November 2023 ballot to expand and enshrine abortion at the expense of protections for women and preborn children. The Catechism of the Catholic Church proclaims that "human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception." The Church accompanies and supports women facing unexpected pregnancies and mothers through programs like Walking with Moms in Need and the services of Catholic Charities.






