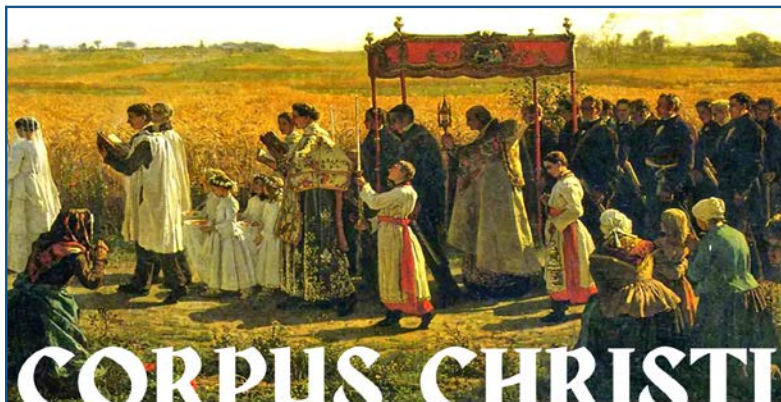

*Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit as it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever! Amen.*

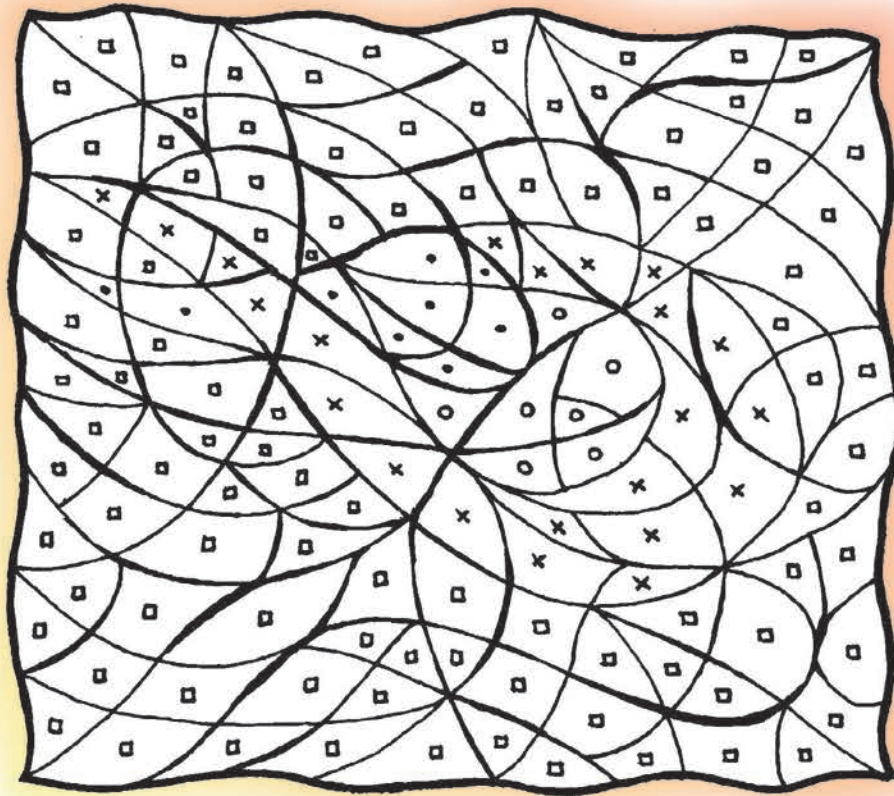

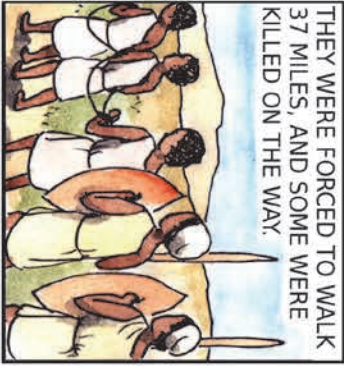
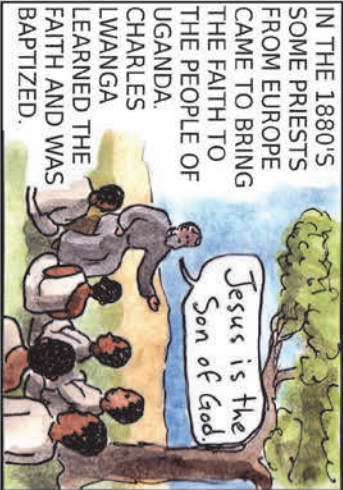
*In what form did the Holy Spirit come to the Apostles on Pentecost?*

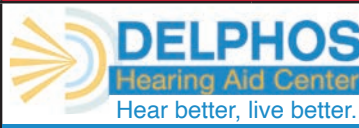
