LITURGICAL GUIDELINES

Effective June 5, 2021

- **FACE MASKS ARE NOT REQUIRED:** The personal decision by some members of the clergy or the faithful to continue wearing masks/facial coverings should be respected out of charity.
- **SEATING WILL NO LONGER BE LIMITED:** Rows will not be limited/closed. According to pastoral need, a designed socially-distanced area will be the two side handicap sections that will be marked for socially-distanced seating.
- **HOLY WATER FONTS WILL BE FILLED:** Holy Water stoops and fonts without filters, or fresh water access, will continue to be cleaned on a regular basis, pending volunteer sign-up for cleaning.
- **THE SIGN OF PEACE MAY BE RESUMED:** The sign of peace does not necessarily imply physical touch with others. Some members of the faithful may still be reluctant to extend/receive a physical Sign of Peace and their preference for no physical contact should be respected.
- **HOLY COMMUNION RECEPTION ON THE HAND OR TONGUE IS THE PREROGATIVE OF THE COMMUNICANT.**
- **DISTRIBUTION OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD WILL NOT BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE ASSEMBLY YET.**
- **OFFERTORY PROCESSION:** At every Mass, the offertory procession will take place, so volunteers are needed to present the gifts to the priest.
- **THE LORD'S PRAYER:** Also, the assembly should refrain from physical contact (handholding) during the Lord's Prayer, a gesture that is not prescribed in the Roman Missal. Extending hands during the Lord's Prayer is reserved to the Priest Celebrant and concelebrating Priests only who pray together with the people (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 237) The assembly not holding hands during the Lord's Prayer is about GIRM (General Instruction of the Roman Missal) and not about GERM (a microorganism, especially one which causes disease).
