**FATHER'S DAY MASS REMEMBRANCE CARD SETS**

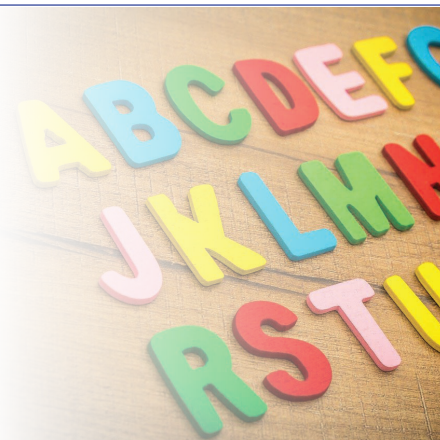

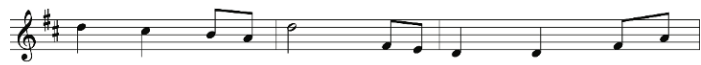
