THE DAY THE RELICS WERE HERE AT ST. JOHN

There really was no other day like this one. We met the Porter, Patricia Oedy-Murray and proceeded to set up the tables for each of the reliquaries and pictures. We also put out four kneelers. The Knights of Columbus were coming in shifts to protect the relics. Others were greeting the visitors.

The first prayer service began at 10:00 a.m. There was fog but we still hoped to have a number of people. As the time approached, Sr. Mary Edward gathered the music, Deacon Gene would read, Fr. Hunyor preside, Seminarian Jay would swing the incense and several servers carried processional candles. Each service and Mass throughout the day would have other persons for these ministries.

Amazingly, everyone who came for the prayers, for veneration were very respectful. Pat would hear those who came with rosaries or prayer cards to be blessed and take them up to the relics or bring the relics down and say the prayers that were the blessing. It seemed that she had walked those steps in front of the altar a thousand times that day. Some came for healing, some for blessings on their studies. If a group of children came, she would show the relic and speak to all of them. By 3:00 p.m., every student at St. John's had been in church for veneration. Around 5:00 p.m., members of the Hispanic community coming off work were arriving. The Vantage members came to the 7:30 p.m. prayer session followed by St. Patrick's Parish School of Religion. From 10:00 in the morning until 8:30 at night, Blessed Carlo and Saint Manuel were venerated and were intercessors for countless parishioners and visitors of our three parishes and beyond.

Throughout these years of the Eucharistic Revival, the miracles of the Eucharist will be displayed in the three parishes. Prayer Cards of Blessed Carlo and Saint Manuel will be available, as well as the Prayer for the Revival. The shortened biographies of these saints will also be available. THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY By: Jack Bockey



Bishop Albert H. Ottenweller was born on April 5, 1916, in Stanford, Montana. When he was around 6 years old, his family moved to Leipsic, Ohio where he attended St. Mary's school. He was ordained a priest on June 19, 1943. His first assignment was at Delphos as associate pastor. 25 years later, he was installed as the 8th pastor of our parish by Msgr. Clarence Yeager on June 20, 1968. He was made auxiliary bishop of Toledo in

1974. He left our parish in 1976 and in 1977, he was made bishop of Steubenville. He retired in 1992. He died September 23, 2012 and is buried at St. Mary's Cemetery, Leipsic, Ohio.




