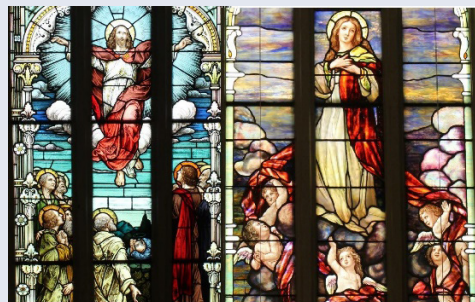

THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By: Jack Bockey*

In 1860, parish groups were organized which included the St. Joseph Society and the Young Ladies' and Young Men's Sodalties. The St. Joseph Society enrolled the married men of the parish and they donated the Ascension window on the north side of church. The Young Ladies' Sodality was dedicated to the Blessed Virgin and they donated the Assumption window on the north side of church. The Young Men's Sodality was dedicated to St. Aloysius. The Young Ladies' & Men's Sodalties were affiliated with parent Sodalties in Rome and were formed to foster high standards of Catholic morality and an appreciation of the Catholic faith among the members.

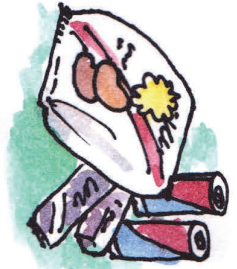

# Jesus teaches us not to be greedy



In today's Gospel reading, a man tells Jesus that his brother is being unfair to him. But Jesus knows that the man is just being greedy, so He tells him the parable of the rich farmer. One year he had such a good harvest that he couldn't fit it all into his barns. He tore down his old barns and built new ones, so that he could store his food for many years. But just when he thought he would be able to rest and enjoy his food, God told him that he would die.

This parable is a warning against being greedy. Jesus is not saying that we should not save some food or that we shouldn't save our money.



He is just telling us to remember that we are going to die one day, and then everything we saved is going to be useless for us. He wants us to use the things we have wisely, but not be too attached to them.

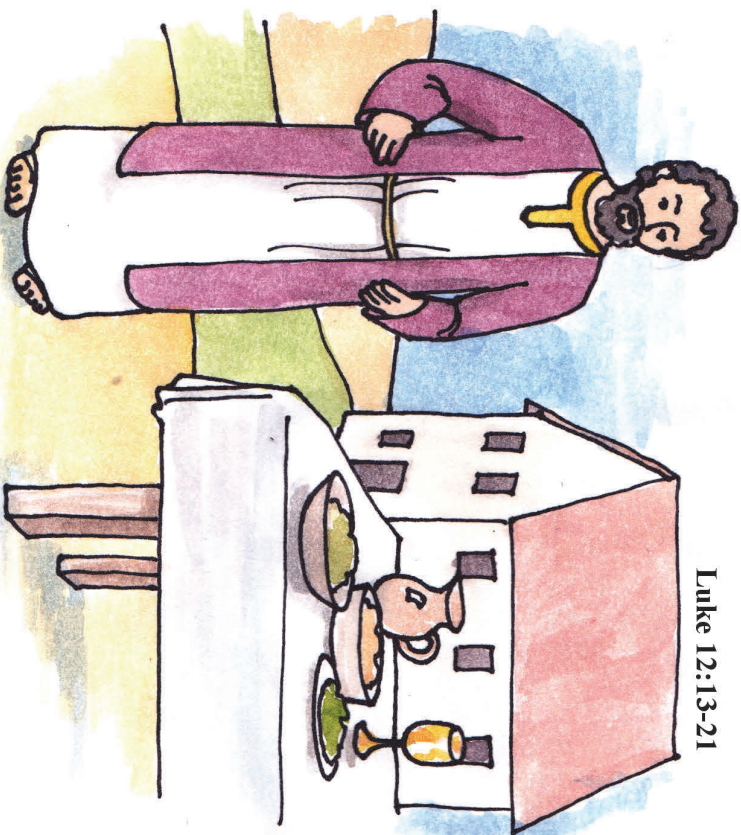

# Saint Peter Julian Eymard

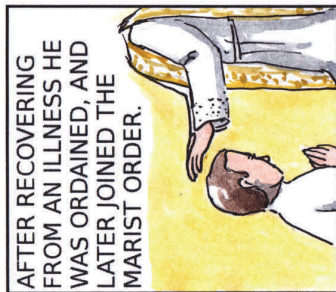

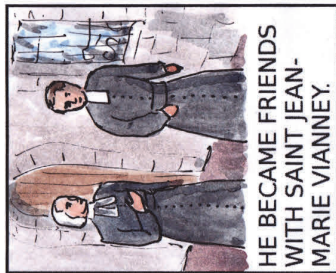
PETER JULIAN EYMARD WAS BORN TO A POOR FAMILY IN FRANCE IN 1811. HE ALWAYS HAD GREAT DEVOTION TO GOD.



HE WANTED TO BECOME A PRIEST BUT AT FIRST HIS FATHER WOULDN'T LET HIM.



AFTER RECOVERING FROM AN ILLNESS HE WAS ORDAINED, AND LATER JOINED THE MARIST ORDER.



HE BECAME FRIENDS WITH SAINT JEAN-MARIE VIANNEY.



FR. PETER JULIAN HAD A GREAT LOVE FOR JESUS IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT.



HE STARTED AN ORDER OF PRIESTS TO HONOUR THE BLESSED SACRAMENT.



IN SPITE OF CHRONIC ILLNESS, HE WROTE SEVERAL BOOKS ON THE BLESSED SACRAMENT AND HELPED START AN ORDER FOR WOMEN.

SAINT PETER JULIAN DIED AT AGE 57 AND WAS CANONIZED IN 1962. WE CAN LEARN FROM HIS LIFE TO LOVE JESUS IN THE BLESSED SACRAMENT. JESUS TOLD US THAT HE IS THE FOOD FOR OUR SOULS, SO THE MORE WE RECEIVE HIM IN HOLY COMMUNION THE STRONGER OUR SOULS WILL BECOME.

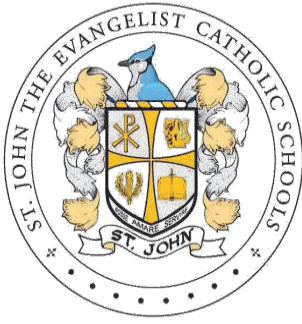

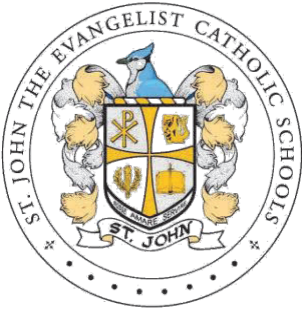
