In February & March 1929, the interior of our church was cleaned and repainted. The altars were repainted as well as the pillars. They were painted in "imitation of marble." This greatly beautified the church. The pillars and altars were painted white in 1944. If you look at the bottom of the second pillar from the back on Mary's side, you can see the the marble paint where the white paint has peeled off.




