Dear Blue Jay Family and Supporters:

Athletics are an important part of today's educational environment. It is in athletics that individuals learn to give their best effort. When student-athletes learn to give their best, they experience joy, satisfaction, and self-confidence. Delphos St. John School has a proud tradition of athletic achievement. Our Catholic experience offers a unique opportunity to use athletics for the purpose of the authentic formation and the spirituality of each student. For that purpose, the School recognizes the role of athletics in the complete formation of every person.

Public and private schools have struggled to continue to fund quality athletic programs. Budgets in educational institutions are extremely tight. At Delphos St. John School, our teachers and other staff continue to sacrifice to help sustain an institution they have grown to love, but the old school funding model needs to adapt, and new ways to support private schools are necessary so that tuition can remain affordable. These changes are needed so that our school can become more competitive in offering all the great benefits to students, faculty, and families.

Delphos St. John Parish and School has started several initiatives to generate revenue through financial endowments. These are set up to support specific areas of the school budget, in the hopes that once enough capital has been generated, they will self-fund programs through investments. An example of a current endowment is the Teacher Financial Assistance Endowment. Our hope is to raise enough revenue through new endowments so more focus can be applied to other areas of education and extra-curriculars that are needed. By law, these endowments are separate from the school, church, or general fund and must be spent for the specific purpose intended. The Athletic Endowment has been established to support our incredible athletic tradition, giving it sustainability for generations of Blue Jays to come.

The focus of this first large fundraising initiative is to begin building capital for the Athletic Endowment. We will be offering a 3" Brass Charter Member Medallion to the first 1000 people, at a cost of \$500 each. You will receive the Medallion, and a stand, with an engraved metal label that includes your name, (~50 characters), and your membership number. The membership number is the order in which you joined the charter. We will also have a large mobile frame that references all charter members, as they join. We plan to bring this frame to sporting events for fans to see until all 1000 slots have been filled and will eventually be displayed permanently inside the hall of St. John's.


This effort does not replace the current Athletic Boosters Club. The revenue generated from the Athletic Endowment will be focused on sports transportation, assisting in paying coaches, and other items that have come from the parish/school budget. The Booster Club will continue to contribute to St. John's Athletics in any means the group decides. For instance, a Hudl Camera for the basketball team film sessions and new uniforms on a six-year rotation, among the many other items, they donate to provide our student-athletes with the best of the best.
