THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By: Jack Bockey*

On September 17, 1929, a new M. P. Moller organ was dedicated by Bishop Strich. The organ had been a gift for Msgr. Rupert's 50th anniversary of the priesthood. An organ recital was held after the dedication. St. John's choir, under the direction of Mrs. R. H. Jettinghoff, and accompanied by Miss Helen Stallkamp on the organ, appeared on the program, together with a group of soloists. Many local and visiting members of the clergy, members of the parish, and relatives and friends of Father Rupert, participated. In 1944, the organ pipes were moved to two side chambers in the choir loft. This organ is still in use today.
