THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By Jack Bockey*

Sometime during 1865, Peter Gangler asked the Delphos pastor (Fr. Westerholt) if he could travel to Landeck once a month to celebrate Mass. The Mass was held in a frame building donated by Sebastian Lee. In 1866, families from Landeck petitioned Bishop Rappe of the Diocese of Cleveland to establish a parish in Landeck, so the parish of St. John the Baptist in Landeck was established. The first frame church was built on a lot of land that was also donated by Sebastian Lee. This is where the church is today.

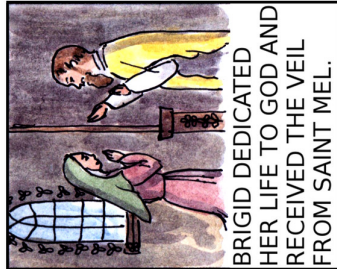
