THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY By Jack Bockey



You may have heard about the special Advent Mass called Rorate Caeli which our parish will be having on December 14, at 6:30 a.m. This ancient tradition dates back to the Middle Ages. A Rorate Caeli Mass is a votive Mass in

honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary celebrated during Advent. At this Mass, the Church is lit only by candles, early in the morning as the sun is rising representing Mary's role of bringing the light into the darkness of the world. This also comes from when Masses were celebrated early in the morning and extra candles were used to light the church. This Mass gets its name from the opening antiphon "Rorate, caeli desuper" Latin for 'Drop down, ye heavens' from Isaiah 45:8. The Mass was common until the 1960s, after that it was mostly forgotten, now more and more parishes are celebrating the Rorate Caeli Mass including our parish. Please come and experience this beautiful tradition.

The Church is lit only by candles, early in the morning as the sun is rising representing Mary's role of bringing the light of the world into the darkness of the world. The mass gets its name from the opening antiphon "Roráte caéli désuper" which is Latin for 'Drop down, ye heavens' from the opening words of Isaiah 45:8. The mass will be in Latin and English with Gregorian Chant.

It will be celebrated Ad Orientem, meaning to the East, this means the priest and the people will all face Jesus in the tabernacle during mass. In the Gospel it says that Jesus will come from the East. The rising of the sun reminds us of the resurrection and the light coming into the darkness. Come and experience this beautiful, ancient tradition!


