Using a smart phone, go to Google Play or the App Store to download the Listen Everywhere app. Once the app is downloaded, go to your phone's settings to connect to the church's Wi-Fi labeled "Hearing Assist." Then you return to the Listen Everywhere App, click on "VENUE SCAN." Press the play button to begin. If you want to stop, press pause. Hearing aids that are connected to Bluetooth may experience a lag in the audio signal. There is a smart device in the priest sacristy that parishioners without hearing aids can use. Ear buds are provided.

THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By Jack Bockey*

After Fr. Maesfrancx left Landeck, Fr. H. F. Seltzers came. He had the first Holy Communion class in the new parish on the feast of St. John the Baptist, June 24th, 1869. During Fr. Seltzer’s time as pastor, a group of “committeemen” were chosen to help manage the affairs of the parish. This group included the three original land donors and John Rahrig. Later, their place was taken by a group of 4 men known as councilmen. In early 1869, the first bell was installed in the church tower to call parishioners to the divine services. Fr. Seltzer was pastor from 1869 to 1871 and was the parish’s second pastor.

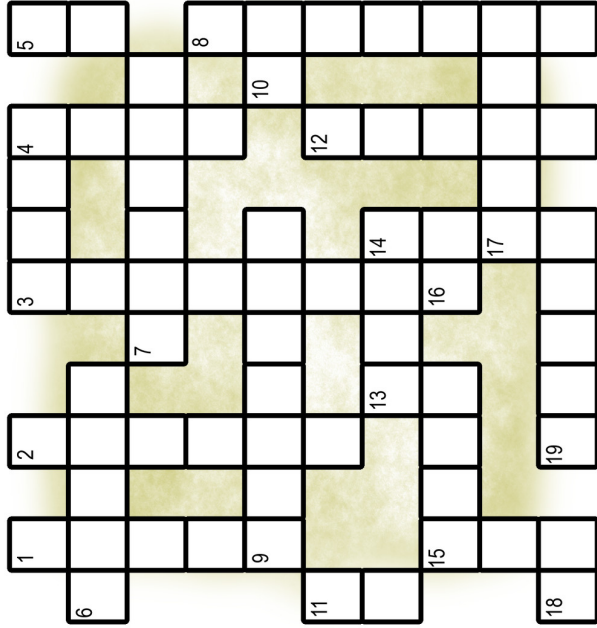
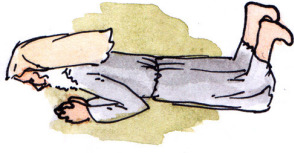

SGO – SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION

You now have the ability to direct your tax dollars to support Delphos St. John the Evangelist School through a Scholarship Fund of the Diocese of Toledo – a Scholarship Granting Organization or SGO. Married couples filing jointly may give up to \$1,500.00. The tax credit for married couples filing jointly will not exceed the taxes paid or \$1,500.00, whichever is less. Please consult your tax preparer on how you would benefit from this tax credit. If you take advantage of this SGO, be sure to:

1. Make checks payable to Diocese of Toledo. Checks cannot be made out to Delphos St. John's nor can donations be made through us on your behalf.
2. Complete the form within the brochure (received in the mail or from the Ministry Center) or online, being sure to mark St. John Elementary and High School, Delphos
