ALL ARE WELCOME AT LANDECK CHURCH

February 25, 2024 after 5:30 p.m. Mass

Recently, The Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith promulgated a document entitled *Fiducia Supplicans*. It has been widely reported by secular media that the document permits the blessings of same sex couples. While it does recognize the blessing of same sex couples, it does not recognize nor validate same sex unions. The Church has not changed its teaching on the Sacrament of Marriage as a Sacrament that unites a man and woman and is ordered to life. The document has more to say about the nature of blessings and who can receive a blessing. As the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith has stated, the document validates nor changes nothing. However, much of the secular media has not reported it that way. Reporting by the media has confused many Catholics.

Fr. Dennis will offer a few remarks on the document on February 25 after the 5:30 p.m. Mass in Landeck. He will offer clarification on what the documents says and what it doesn't say. He also will offer a few remarks on a Catholic perspective on the war in Ukraine and also the current conflict in Israel and Gaza.

The comments should run 45 minutes with 15 minutes for questions.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS – FAMILIES NEEDED

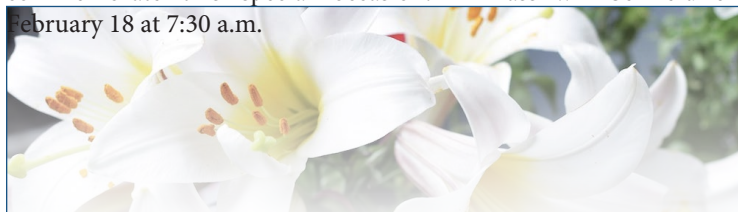

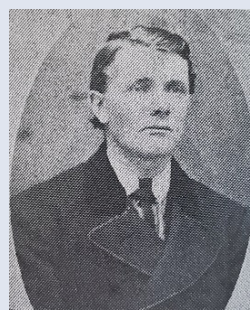

THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By Jack Bockey*



After Fr. Seltzer left, Fr. Fidelius Brem was appointed pastor in April of 1871. Soon after his arrival, he set about having a rectory and several other houses built near the church to encourage people to come settle near the church. Father Brem was a very zealous priest and besides ministering to the people of Landeck, he would also travel to the missions at Spencerville, Van Wert, and Convoy. He would often take a boy from Landeck to serve Mass. More on Fr. Brem next week.
