THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY

Shortly after its founding, the Knights of Columbus Council 1362 considered new quarters. It was proposed that the Knights of Columbus and the Catholic Knights of Ohio join in the erection or securing of joint quarters. This plan was voted down. In 1911, two ideas were considered: part of the St. Mary's school building could be remodeled into lodge quarters or rent quarters on the third floor of the recently built Commercial Bank building. It was decided to rent the Commercial Bank building. This served as K of C Hall until 1958 when it was decided to buy the Herman Dienstberger building and lot on West Fourth Street for a K of C home. The deal was made but later was cancelled and it was decided to erect a new building on Second Street (Elida Avenue). This info was found on the K of C Council 1362 website.

SGO - SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION

If you take advantage of this SGO, be sure to:

- **1. Make checks payable to Diocese of Toledo**. Checks cannot be made out to Delphos St. John's nor can donations be made through us on your behalf.
- **2. Complete the form within the brochure** (received in the mail or from the Ministry Center) **or online**, being sure to mark St. John, Delphos

If by mail, return the check (made payable to Diocese of Toledo) and form to: Diocese of Toledo Scholarship Fund, 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, OH 43604.

If online, scan this code and follow the steps necessary, selecting St. John Elementary and High School, Delphos.






