### ALL ARE WELCOME AT LANDECK CHURCH

### February 25, 2024 after 5:30 p.m. Mass

Recently, The Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith promulgated a document entitled Fiducia Supplicans. It has been widely reported by secular media that the document permits the blessings of same sex couples. While it does recognize the blessing of same sex couples, it does not recognize nor validate same sex unions. The Church has not changed its teaching on the Sacrament of Marriage as a Sacrament that unites a man and woman and is ordered to life. The document has more to say about the nature of blessings and who can receive a blessing. As the Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith has stated, the document neither validates nor changes anything. However, much of the secular media has not reported it that way. Reporting by the media has confused many Catholics.

Fr. Dennis will offer a few remarks on the document on February 25 after the 5:30 p.m. Mass in Landeck. He will offer clarification on what the documents say and what it doesn't say. He also will offer a few remarks on a Catholic perspective on the war in Ukraine and also the current conflict in Israel and Gaza.

The comments should run 45 minutes with 15 minutes for questions.

### THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY By Jack Bockey



In the late summer of 1876 or 1877, (the date is not known for sure), Fr. Brem left Landeck to return to his home country of Switzerland. It was on this trip that he purchased the painting of St. John the Baptist. In October, 1876, the parish house caught fire and burned to the ground destroying all the parish records and its contents. Fr. Brem returned in December 1876 or 1877. In 1878, the bishop of the Diocese of Little Rock, AR succeeded in getting Fr. Brem to

come to Arkansas to start parishes. He founded a catholic church in the small town of Atkins and another church in the town of Conway. Eventually having become blind, he returned to his home country of Switzerland where he founded another parish and died in 1892. The photo is of Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church in Atkins.





## DIOCESE OF TOLEDO IN COMPLIANCE FOLLOWING SAFE ENVIRONMENT AUDIT

Each year, the Diocese of Toledo is required to undergo an audit to ensure that it is in compliance with the articles of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. The past year's audit was a data collection process, examining the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. Bishop Daniel Thomas is pleased to announce that the Diocese was found to be in full compliance with the requirements in the Charter following the audit.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. ### Second Sunday of Lent: Listening for the Voice of God

WORK OF MERCY: Bear Wrongs Patiently

THE GRACE I SEEK: to recognize the voice of Jesus in my life

### IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND OF THE SON, AND OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. AMEN.

Pause for a few moments, and allow yourself to become aware of Jesus' gift of himself in the Eucharist. Realize that, at this very moment, the Lord of Life is gazing upon you with great love. Allow yourself to receive his loving gaze. You are his beloved child. Rest in his loving gaze.

Thank Jesus for the gift of himself in the Eucharist.

ASK FOR THE GRACE: Jesus, help me to trust you are speaking to me and to recognize your voice.

**SCRIPTURE MEDITATION** — Read slowly, 3–4 times. Allow the words of Scripture to wash over your mind and heart. Allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you through this passage.

"I swear by myself, declares the LORD, that because you acted as you did in not withholding from me your beloved son, I will bless you abundantly and make your descendants as countless as the stars of the sky and the sands of the seashore." (Genesis 22:16–17)

**REFLECTION QUESTION** — Allow yourself to sit with these questions for a while, being attentive to how the Lord is speaking in your heart.

The Lord often asks difficult things of us, especially if our hearts have wandered away from him. However, he always blesses us more than we could have ever imagined when we follow his promptings. What is one concrete blessing in your life Jesus has given you after you chose to listen to and follow him?

**SCRIPTURE MEDITATION** — Read slowly, 3–4 times. Again, allow the words of Scripture to wash over your mind and heart. Let the Holy Spirit speak to you through this passage.

"Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.' Suddenly, looking around, they no longer saw anyone but Jesus alone with them." (Mark 9:7–8)

**REFLECTION QUESTION** — Allow yourself to sit with these questions for a while, being attentive to how the Lord is speaking in your heart.

Gazing upon the Eucharist, recognize that Jesus is with you. The Father tells us in this Gospel reading that Jesus is his beloved Son. Is there an area of your heart that still struggles to believe that this is really God's beloved Son, present in a most special way in the Eucharist? Ask Jesus to help you see his face and hear his voice in the Blessed Sacrament.

Remain in silence with the Lord. Allow him to speak in the silence, in your heart. Receive his presence. If it helps, write down what you sense the Lord communicating to you during this time of prayer.

**CLOSING PRAYER** — O God, who have commanded us to listen to your beloved Son, be pleased, we pray, to nourish us inwardly by your word, that, with spiritual sight made pure, we may rejoice to behold your glory. 
