

THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY



The original pews of our church were made of oak and were divided at the pillars. This may be why the Communion line is the way it is today. In the transepts, some of the pews were made of black walnut as these were from the 2nd church, where they were installed in 1856, and brought to the current church when it was built. The

original pews were replaced with the current ones in 1950. Some original pews were left in the choir loft until 1998 when they were replaced and auctioned off.

SGO - SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION

You now have the ability to direct your tax dollars to support St. John the Evangelist Catholic School through a Scholarship Fund of the Diocese of Toledo – a Scholarship Granting Organization or SGO. Brochures have been sent to all of our Ohio Parishioners and School Ohio Alumni. We hope you have received yours in the mail. If not, there are some available in the back of church or at the Ministry Center. A taxpayer will receive a tax credit up to \$750.00 for State income taxes paid. A tax credit will not exceed the taxes paid or \$750.00, whichever is less. Married couples filing jointly may give up to \$1,500.00. The tax credit for married couples filing jointly will not exceed the taxes paid or \$1,500.00, whichever is less. Please consult your tax preparer on how you would benefit from this tax credit. If you take advantage of this SGO, be sure to:

- **1. Make checks payable to Diocese of Toledo**. Checks cannot be made out to Delphos St. John's nor can donations be made through us on your behalf.
- **2. Complete the form within the brochure** (received in the mail or from the Ministry Center) **or online**, being sure to mark St. John, Delphos.

If by mail, return the check (made payable to Diocese of Toledo) and form to: Diocese of Toledo Scholarship Fund, 1933 Spielbusch Avenue, Toledo, OH 43604.

If online, scan this code and follow the steps necessary, selecting St. John Elementary and High School, Delphos:



ST. JOHN'S CEMETERY MAINTENANCE PROJECT

Thank you to everyone who has donated or pledged funds to this project. As of January 31st, \$35,405.00 has been pledged and/or received.

After considering the cost and benefits of repairing verses replacing the maintenance building at St. John's Cemetery, the Cemetery Board has recommended to Bishop Walsh that the building be replaced. The maintenance buildings current condition requires a new roof, the rafters need to be straightened or replaced and the two garage doors replaced due to the damage from the sagging rafters. Currently the entire building is heated during the winter season to keep the water system from freezing. A small heated room needs to be constructed around the water system to save on the utility cost. We also looked at larger garage doors for ease of moving the tractor and dump truck in and out of the building along with raising the rafters to allow maintenance work on the equipment to be done inside the building. The cost of a new metal pole building, the same size as the current building, keeping the current concrete floor is estimated at \$54,407.00. The Diocese requires that the estimated funds be received or pledged before the project is started. The Cemetery Board is asking for your help for this project.
