THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY

March 25th may be one of the most important dates in history. It is the Feast of the Annunciation, but did you know that March 25th is also understood by Christians as the day on which God created man, the day on which Adam and Eve fell, and the day on which our Lord was crucified? The *Martyrologium Hieronymianum* (the oldest serving list of important Christian martyrdoms and dates) list all of these events. We don't know for sure that all of these happened on March 25, but the early Christians believed that these very important events must share the same date as they all complement and fulfill each other. Some say that Jesus died on 15 Nisan of the Jewish calendar which is March 25 on the Roman calendar. Jewish tradition held that a great man would die on the date of his conception, so the date of Jesus's conception must be the date of his death, and from there we get the date of Christmas. 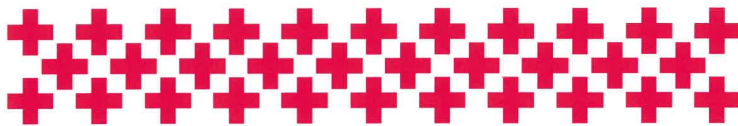
