CHRISM MASS

As we continue to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Hope, kindly join us for the celebration of the annual Chrism Mass during which the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens are blessed; the Sacred Chrism is consecrated; and our diocesan and religious priests renew their priestly promises. We invite all the faithful of the Diocese of Toledo to “pray for your Priests, that the Lord may pour out his gifts abundantly upon them, and keep them faithful as ministers of Christ, the High Priest, so that they may lead you to him, who is the source of salvation” (Roman Missal, Chrism Mass, Renewal of Priestly Promises).

Parish representatives from around the diocese will be present and will take the blessed/consecrated oils back to their communities to be used in the celebration of the sacraments during the next year.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Sunday, April 27th is Divine Mercy Sunday. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be sung before the 9:15 am Mass and booklets will be at the doors of the church that detail the feast. Divine Mercy is based on the private revelations of St. Faustina Kowalska. In 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized St. Faustina and said, “It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church will be called Divine Mercy Sunday.” The Divine Mercy image is a depiction of Jesus based on a vision that St. Faustina had in 1931. In the image, Jesus is shown in most versions as raising his right hand in blessing and pointing with his left hand on his chest from which flow forth two rays: one red and one white (translucent). Red for the blood of Jesus (which is the Life of Souls) and pale for water (which justify souls). The whole image is symbolic of charity, forgiveness and love of God, referred to as the “Fountain of Mercy.” The depictions often contain the message “Jesus, I trust in You!”

ROAD TO RESURRECTION


Reflection on Luke 22:14–23:56

Palm Sunday always invites us to enter the holiest week of the year by hearing the entire Passion story of Jesus, a story that we will hear and celebrate in its essential parts from Holy Thursday, through Good Friday, the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. We are invited to enter into the story ourselves, to allow the story of Jesus' suffering, death and Resurrection to interpret our lives.

We are not viewing a movie – one more bathrobe Bible-drama in Hollywood's cinematic library. We are hearing and telling our story: the Passion of Christ as it continues to be lived out today. We are not just remembering historical events, but committing ourselves to follow the same path as the Lord Jesus. For this path – the Paschal Mystery – the mystery of dying and rising – is the central reality of the life of every follower of Jesus.

We are all pilgrims on the same road, and our individual stories now merge with the story of Jesus this week, as we walk with the same faith toward the same destination. And how good it is for us to be in community, for who, like Jesus, could walk this road alone?

SAINT BERNADETTE SOUBIROUS

Saint of the Day: April 16

Patron Saint of bodily illness

Bernadette Soubirous was born in 1844, the first child of an extremely poor miller in the town of Lourdes in southern France. The family was living in the basement of a dilapidated building when on February 11, 1858, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette in a cave above the banks of the Gave River near Lourdes. Bernadette, 14 years old, was known as a virtuous girl though a dull student who had not even made her first Holy Communion. In poor health, she had suffered from asthma from an early age. There were 18 appearances in all, the final one occurring on the feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, July 16.

According to Bernadette, the Lady of her visions was a girl of 16 or 17 who wore a white robe with a blue sash. Yellow roses covered her feet, a large rosary was on her right arm. In the vision on March 25, she told Bernadette, "I am the Immaculate Conception." It was only when the words were explained to her that Bernadette came to realize who the Lady was.

Few visions have ever undergone the scrutiny that these appearances of the Immaculate Virgin were subject to. Lourdes became one of the most popular Marian shrines in the world, attracting millions of visitors. Miracles were reported at the shrine and in the waters of the spring. After thorough investigation, Church authorities confirmed the authenticity of the apparitions in 1862.

During her life, Bernadette suffered much. She was hounded by the public as well as by civic officials until at last she was protected in a convent of nuns. Five years later, she petitioned to enter the Sisters of Notre Dame of Nevers. After a period of illness she was able to make the journey from Lourdes and enter the novitiate. But within four months of her arrival she was given the last rites of the Church and allowed to profess her vows. She died on April 16, 1879, at the age of 35. Bernadette Soubirous was canonized in 1933.
