were made in Columbus and Fort Wayne. The windows cost from \$700.00 to \$1,200.00 each at the time they were made.

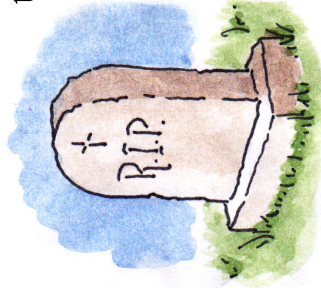
Jesus' Body Came Back to Life!

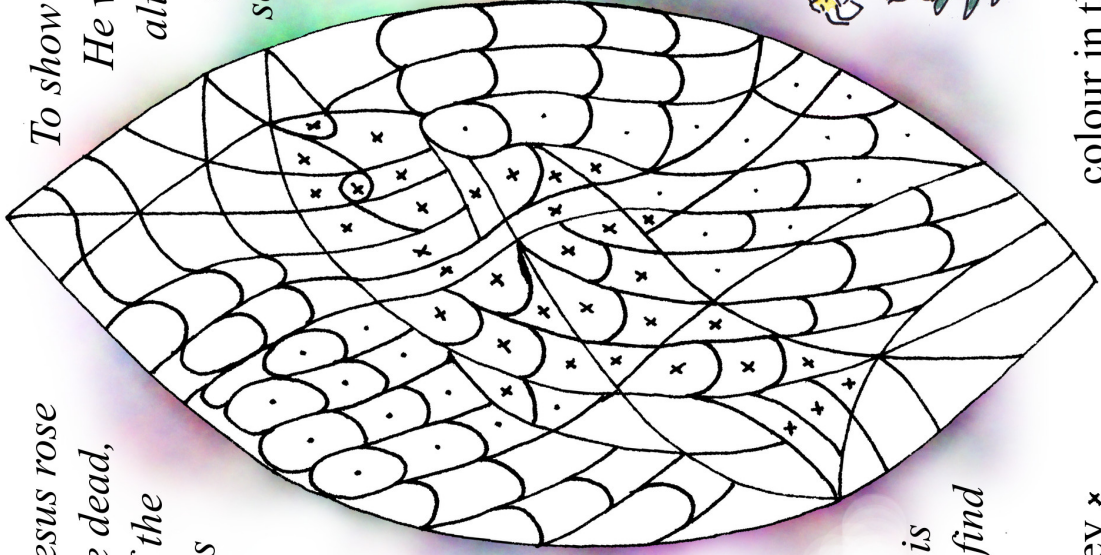

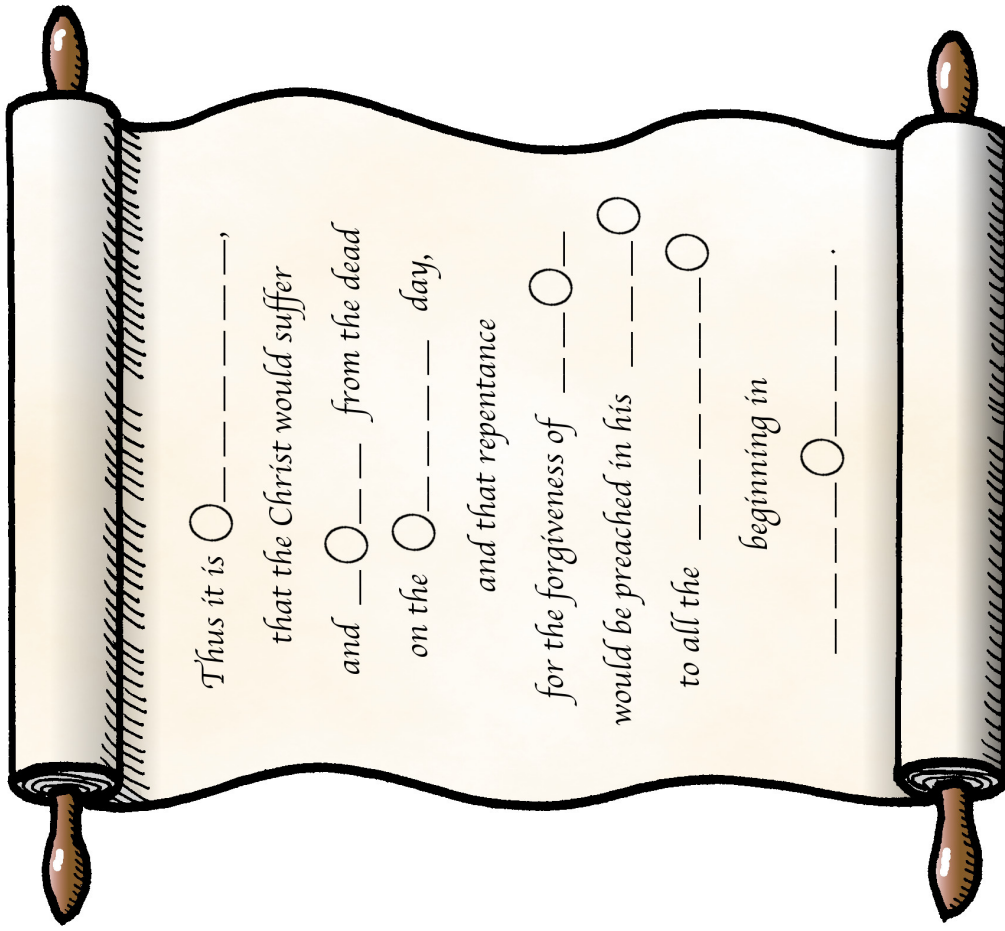

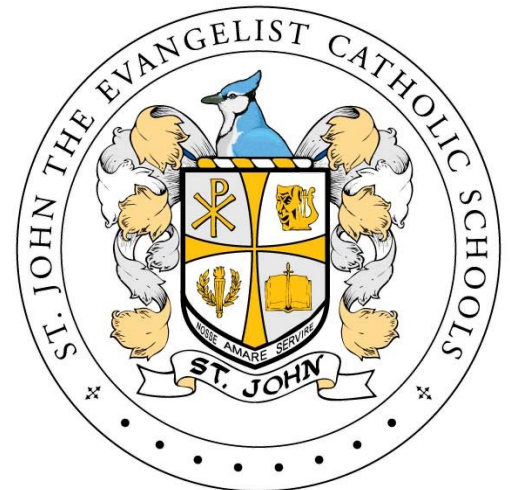
