THIS WEEK IN PARISH HISTORY *By Jack Bockey*

Since the beginning of Delphos St. John's High School in 1913, the school always had either a sister or associate pastor as its principal. But in May 1970, as vocations in the Diocese of Toledo started to drop, the pastor and parish school board found it necessary to hire a lay principal for the first time. In September of 1970, George Adams became the first lay principal to serve our high school. He served as principal for 25 years until retiring in 1995.




CHURCH CAMP 2024

Disrupt our comfortable lives and complacent attitudes with new ideas to respond courageously and creativity with a daily ‘YES!’ Amen.






